Acts 2,14-17.21.37-39.41-42 – Being a Christian

14 But Peter, standing with the eleven, lifted up his voice and addressed them: “Men of Judea and all who dwell in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and give ear to my words.

15 For these people are not drunk. [...]

16 But this is what was uttered through the prophet Joel:

17 “And in the last days it shall be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh.

21 And it shall come to pass that everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.’

37 Now when they heard this they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, “Brothers, what shall we do?”

38 And Peter said to them, “Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

39 For the promise is for you and for your children and for all who are far off, everyone whom the Lord our God calls to himself.”

41 So those who received his word were baptized, and there were added that day about three thousand souls.

42 And they devoted themselves to the apostles’ teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.

Questions (if needed)

- What could that mean, "drunk" by the Holy Spirit?
- Are you happy to be saved as a Christian? When were such moments? How did you feel?
- Have you ever had a moment like Peter when it just gushed out of you? Do you dare to tell about Jesus?
- Are you holding on to the 4 things? How do you do that? Where do you find it difficult? (Teaching of the apostles, community, breaking of bread, prayers)

Bible Introduction

This week we will do BibleSharing.

1. The bible text is read again out loud.
2. Everyone reads out single words, phrases, verses, that stick on your mind/raise questions/that leave a nasty taste. Important: only name it from the text! It will be discussed later!
3. Everyone can now say something about his/her word/phrase/verse and the others can ask questions or add their thoughts.

This way a conversation starts.
