1st John 4,16-21 - Love

16 So we have come to know and to believe the love that God has for us. God is love, and whoever abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him.

17 By this is love perfected with us, so that we may have confidence for the day of judgment, because as he is so also are we in this world.

18 There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love.

19 We love because he first loved us.

20 If anyone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen.

21 And this commandment we have from him: whoever loves God must also love his brother.

Questions (if needed)

- What does "to remain/to abide in love" (v. 16) mean for you?
- Has love for God or for a person ever helped you to overcome fear? How was it?
- "Blood is thicker than water." What does sibling-love mean to you?
- How does love feel in Taizé? How do brothers and sisters in faith love nowadays?

Bible Introduction

2. Everyone reads out single words, phrases, verses, that stick on your mind/raise questions/that leave a nasty taste. Important: only name it from the text! It will be discussed later!
