Mk 2,1-5 - together

1 And when he returned to Capernaum after some days, it was reported that he was at home.

2 And many were gathered together, so that there was no more room, not even at the door. And he was preaching the word to them.

3 And they came, bringing to him a paralytic carried by four men.

4 And when they could not get near him because of the crowd, they removed the roof above him, and when they had made an opening, they let down the bed on which the paralytic lay.

5 And when Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven."

Questions (if needed)

- Have you ever been in a situation like the paralyzed man and his friends? How have you ever made the impossible possible together with your friends?
- Did you discover or experience anything new in the last year? Are you doing some things differently now than you were before the pandemic?
- What does the word "together" mean to you now after 2 years with the pandemic?
- What does trust have to do with community for you?

Bible Introduction

This week we will do BibleSharing.

1. The bible text is read again out loud.
2. Everyone reads out single words, phrases, verses, that stick on your mind/raise questions/that leave a nasty taste. Important: only name it from the text! It will be discussed later!
3. Everyone can now say something about his/her word/phrase/verse and the others can ask questions or add their thoughts.

This way a conversation starts.
